What is TECC?

TECC course presents the three phases of tactical care and integrates parallel EMS nomenclature:

- Hot Zone/Direct Threat Care that is rendered while under attack or in adverse conditions.
- Warm Zone/Indirect Threat Care that is rendered while the threat has been suppressed but may resurface at any point.
- Cold Zone/Evacuation Care that is rendered while the casualty is being evacuated from the incident site.

TECC courses have been designed to improve the quality of trauma care and decrease mortality.

What does TECC cover?

Hemorrhage control; surgical airway control and needle decompression; creating a casualty collection point (CCP); strategies for treating wounded responders in threatening environments; management of shock; prevention and treatment of eye injuries; caring for paediatric patients; and techniques for dragging and carrying victims to safety.

Professional Pathways Entry Criteria

TECC is a 16-hour course for EMS practitioners and other prehospital providers.

TECC Skills Framework

TECC is developed by the U.S. Department of Defence, Defence Health Agency (DHA) Joint Trauma System to teach evidence-based, life-saving techniques and strategies for providing the best trauma care on the battlefield. Prometheus Medical is a part of NAEMT affiliate faculty that conducts these courses.

How long is TECC valid for?

TECC certificate is valid for 4 years.

Course Content

The 16-hour classroom course includes all new patient simulations and covers the following topics:

- Hemorrhage control including immediate action drills for tourniquet application throughout the course
- Complete coverage of the MARCH assessment
- Surgical airway control and needle decompression
- Strategies for treating wounded responders in threatening environments
- Caring for paediatric patients
- Techniques for dragging and carrying patients to safety
- Final simulation
